Steel surfaces to be coated must be clean and free from grease. For maximum protection, it is essential to pre-treat components prior to the application of **Interpon 610**. Iron phosphate and zinc phosphate of ferrous metals improve corrosion resistance.

Aluminum substrate may require a chromate conversion coating.

Application

Interpon 610 powders can be applied by manual or automatic electronic spray equipment. It is recommended that for consistent application and appearance product be fluidized during application. Unused powder can be reclaimed using suitable equipment and recycled through the coating system.

Additional Information

Interpon 610 powders have no chalking and slight gloss loss after 12 months Florida exposure but no film breakdown or reduction in protective properties.
